

Force explores dual tech

Calcutta: Pune-based Force Motors on Wednesday unveiled a new-generation platform that has been simultaneously designed and developed for both internal combustion engines and electric drives.

Codenamed T1N, the platform will roll out 12-18 seater vehicles, Prasun Firodia, MD of Force Motors, told **The Telegraph**.

The company has invested around Rs 1,000 crore in this platform that has been developed over the last four years.

A successor to the company's Traveller, T1N will have a number of variants, a 9-10 seater, a 12-seater and an-18 seater.

When asked if the Traveller will be discontinued, Firodia said: "The Traveller is a market leader in its segment. We have no plans to discontinue it. The T1N will cater to the more high-end segments such as hospitality and premium tour and travel."
